Mitigation measures specific for academic year 2024-2025

The following provisions **only** apply for courses up to MQF Level 6 academic year 2023-2024 due to the exceptional extenuating circumstances that occurred towards the end of the academic year 2023 - 2024

MCAST will waive:

- a. Amount of failed units that can be carried forward
- b. Failed core units (This does not apply for B. Eng courses and for the BSc (Hons) in Civil and Structural Engineering)
- c. Rule that dissertation grades cannot be appealed
- d. The 59% capped mark for synoptic assessment

Regulated Professions or some form of Professional Registrations or requirements:

All continuing and progressing students (those who will be assigned Administrative Passes) following courses leading to **Regulated Professions or some form of Professional Registrations or requirements** will be informed by their Institutes that they **have to** sit for/resit all pending assessments and synoptic exams including synoptics already scheduled for September 2024 or on the first available opportunity.

Similarly, eligibility requirements for entry into warranted and regulated courses are obligatory. Students having Administrative Passes at the point of entry into specific courses, have to sit/re-sit all pending assessments and synoptic exams by the end of academic year 2024 – 2025. Successful achievement of respective entry requirements will guarantee continuation of course.

Successful completion of all study units is obligatory:

- for eligibility to a Regulated Profession or some form of Professional Registration or requirement on successful completion of course
- for entry into a Regulated Profession or some form of Professional Registration or requirement
