Dear Students,

The MCAST Erasmus+ Projects and Mobility Office would like to inform you that a Call for Applications under Erasmus+ is currently open. Erasmus+ is offering opportunities for a minimum of two-month **work placement** or a **study abroad for a full semester**. This is a great opportunity to gain work experience in your area of studies, or conduct academic study in another European country and experience a different European culture.

What opportunities do I have?

There are two types of mobility available as follows (please read carefully to see if you qualify):

1. Erasmus+ student mobility for traineeship/placement

- Internship for practical learning at a host company in Europe (min. 2 months).
- Travel between July and September 2023.
- Available for all level 5-6 higher education students¹.
- If a student is successfully selected, MCAST will do its utmost to find a traineeship for the selected students, however it is highly recommended that the students also search, find and propose a traineeship themselves. This would fast-track the traineeship research process.

2. Erasmus+ student mobility for studies

- Study at another European educational institution for a full semester.
- Travel between August 2023 and February 2024, depending on the academic calendar and course schedule of the receiving institution.
- Available only for level 5-6 higher education students currently in their <u>first year</u> of studies. The selected candidates will travel abroad during the <u>first semester of their second year</u>.
- The participation of students in this opportunity is limited by the number of available subjects taught in English language, that are relevant to the course of studies undertaken at MCAST and totalling 30 ECTS.
- <u>Being selected as a possible candidate does not guarantee participation.</u> Confirmation of places available needs to be obtained from our partner institutions after the application period and will be communicated accordingly by the Erasmus+ Projects and Mobility Office by end of June 2023.

Erasmus+ will provide funding towards flights and subsistence according to the Programme guidelines. Other details such as accommodation, dates and countries cannot be communicated at this early stage. If successful with their applications, each student will be consulted individually and the dates of the Erasmus+ mobility be decided by the Erasmus+ Projects and Mobility Office after consulting the Institutes/Colleges.

¹ If you are on your final year of studies, you can still apply: recent higher education graduates may also participate in an Erasmus+ mobility for traineeship/placement abroad.







How can I apply?

You can apply by filling in the Erasmus+ Higher Education application form on pages 4-8. The MCAST Erasmus+ Projects and Mobility Office requires the following documentation:

- The original application
- Copy of your up-to-date Europass CV
- A digital version (pdf) of the CV sent as an email attachment to Desiree.Civelli@mcast.edu.mt

Where can I go?

Erasmus+ mobilities can take place in the following countries:

Belgium, Bulgaria, Czech Republic, Denmark, Germany, Estonia, Ireland, Greece, Spain, France, Croatia, Italy, Cyprus, Latvia, Lithuania, Luxembourg, Hungary, Netherlands, Austria, Poland, Portugal, Romania, Slovenia, Slovakia, Finland, Sweden, North Macedonia, Iceland, Liechtenstein, Norway, Turkey and Serbia.

The student **does not select** the country in the application. <u>Student Mobility for Studies</u> is limited by existing partnerships between MCAST and institutions in these countries. Students who are successful in applying for a <u>Student Mobility for Placement</u> will have a chance to search for a placement in any of the countries above.

Covid-19

It is the students' responsibility to check the Covid-19 requirements of the host country before travelling. These requirements may change at the last minute. This applies also to travellers returning to Malta.

Students with special needs

Students with special needs can benefit from additional support including the possibility of an accompanying person. If you have a special need, please indicate it in the appropriate section of the application.

Submission of Applications

Kindly submit your application by not later than <u>Friday 11th November 2022 at 16:00</u> at the Erasmus+ Projects and Mobility Office, Students' House 3rd floor, MCAST Main campus. Late applications will not be accepted.

Make sure that your applications are duly **signed and stamped** by the director or a deputy director of your institute as indicated. Applications that are not signed will not be accepted.

Applications with missing signatures or stamps will <u>not be accepted</u>. Please submit one original application to the Erasmus+ Projects and Mobility Office by the deadline. Also please submit a <u>digital copy</u> of your Europass CV to <u>desiree.civelli@mcast.edu.mt</u> with the subject stating: HE Student Mobility Application. Students are encouraged to apply only if they are certain of their availability.

After the deadline for application expires, each application will be checked at the Erasmus+ Projects and Mobility Office to confirm eligibility. Once eligibility is confirmed each application will be evaluated, and the final mark will also take into consideration the academic performance and attendance of the students. Each student will be given a ranking which will be used to allocate Erasmus+ funding at ESGAC committee. The number of students we can send for Erasmus+ mobilities depends on the amount of Erasmus+ funding available, and in case of Student Mobility for Studies also on the availability of places at the partner universities that offer suitable courses. While MCAST will do its utmost to find a traineeship for the selected students, students are also encouraged to look for a traineeship themselves.







Data Protection and Privacy Policy
